



RISK MANAGEMENT / SAFETY PLAN REQUIREMENTS FOR COMPETITION BEING HELD AT LEVEL 2

(with examples of what you could implement in red)

- Do not attend if you feel unwell
- Maximum number of attendees will be 100 (this includes committee, judges, pipers etc)
(to keep under 100 persons, no non-competitive siblings of competitors can attend, and only one supporting adult per competitors allowed)
Or (you could arrange events so that only specific age groups are in venue at one time)
- Contact Tracing: Must have a contact tracing system in place for all attendees.
(QR Code or manual sign in system for those who cant scan in)
- HYGIENE:
Hand Sanitiser will be available throughout the venue:
 - At entry points of venue, In bathrooms, changing facilities, and must be used by competitors before and after all Reel events.Wash room facilities have liquid soap and disposable paper towels.
Suitable rubbish receptacles must be provided.
- Masks to be worn by all attendees. Competitors will remove mask prior to competing but may wear mask during performance if they wish.
- PHYSICAL DISTANCING:
 - 1 metre rule to be applied and avoid interaction with people you do not know.
 - Avoid congregating at the door entrance to venue.
 - Competitors will sit at 1m distance by the stage prior to event
(NB. ensure that changing facilities have a maximum of one person per square metre)
- VENTILATION:
 - All doors or windows that can be opened will remain open to ensure good ventilation where no air conditioning system available.
- KITCHEN:
 - No food sales will be conducted.
 - Food preparation for Judges and officials must be conducted with increased hygiene measures in place – gloves to be worn and tongs used etc.
- Organisers will either pre draw events or have the board steward draw for all competitors.
- Swords to be placed and handled only by the board stewards on the day. In the event of the sword needing adjusting after a previous dancer has misplaced, then this will be corrected by the board steward prior to next competitor coming onto the stage.
- Reel Dances – dances must sanitise before and after performing.
- If you feel unwell after attending the competition, please check with the Ministry of Health website for advice on what you should do and how to proceed.
